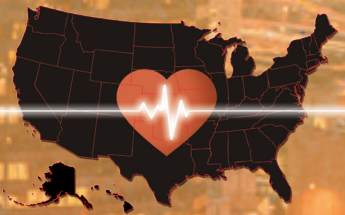

GUEST SPEAKER

Kenneth C. Ulmer, D. Min., Ph.D.



Dr. Ulmer is a founding board member and the former president of The King's University in Los Angeles, California. Dr. Ulmer currently serves as an adjunct professor and dean of The King's at Oxford; an annual summer session held at Oxford University.

Dr. Ulmer received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Broadcasting & Music from the University of Illinois. After accepting his call to the ministry, Dr. Ulmer founded Macedonia Bible Church in San Pedro, California. He received a Ph.D. from Grace Graduate School of Theology in Long Beach, California, and received his Doctor of Ministry from United Theological Seminary.

Dr. Ulmer was consecrated Bishop of Christian Education of the Full Gospel Baptist Church Fellowship, where he served as a founding member on the Bishops Council. He has also served on the Pastor's Advisory Council to the mayor of the City of Inglewood, California. Dr. Ulmer is currently the Presiding Bishop of Macedonia International Bible Fellowship, based in Johannesburg, South Africa, an association of pastors representing ministries in Africa and the U.S.

Dr. Ulmer has written several books including A New Thing (a reflection on the Full Gospel Baptist Movement), Spiritually Fit to Run the Race (a guide to godly living), and his latest book Passionate God.

Dr. Ulmer and his wife have been married for 38 years and have two daughters, one son and five grandchildren.
