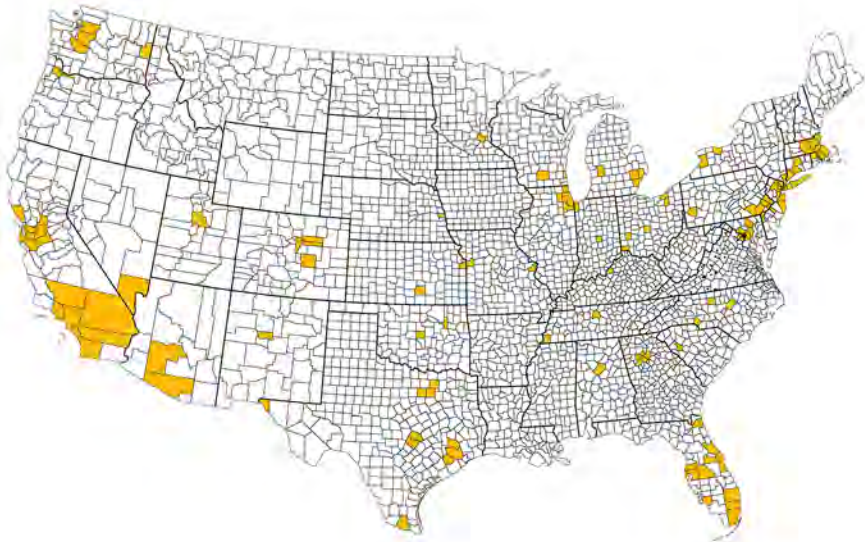

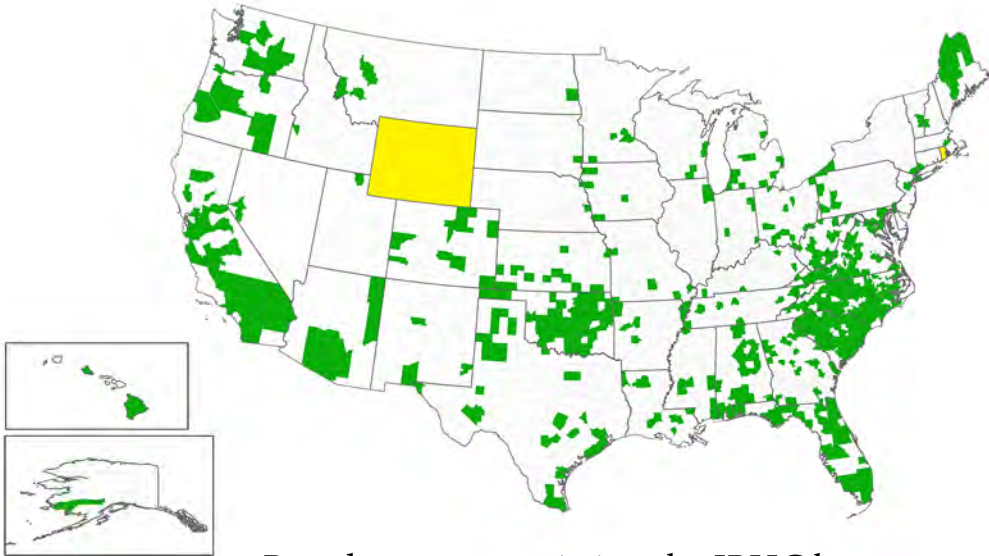
2000th Anniversary of the Death of Christ
