

SYMBOL EXPLANATION

Throughout the ROOTED Curriculum you will notice a variety of teacher helps represented with various symbols. We've included these "helps" to assist you in engaging, educating, and encouraging the children in your class. Below is an explanation of each symbol you'll come across while using this curriculum.



Helpful Hint- Each time we've included a symbol of a light bulb, we are providing a suggestion on how to make your teaching/lesson presentation go as smoothly as possible.



Teachable Moment- The symbol of a clipboard with a pencil is indicating a "teachable moment." This is a time when you should pause your lesson and provide further explanation to your children. We sneak "teachable moments" into the curriculum strategically to remind you, the teacher, to break something down so it is easier for the kids to understand.



Leader Tip- When you see a symbol of a person teaching, you have encountered a tip that we hope will enhance your leadership in the classroom. Our goal with "Leader Tips" is to make you the best leader you can be!



Classroom Management Suggestion- The teacher and student learning symbol indicates a classroom management tip. Classroom management is often the most difficult part of teaching children, but it can also make all the difference in a successful class! These suggestions offer help in dealing with behavioral issues, class distractions, and creating order from chaos.



Helping Hand- When you come across the symbol of two hands, we are giving you tips on how to assist kids who need a "helping hand." These hints can encompass kids who have special needs or for kids who simply need some extra attention.
