Discussion Questions:

Use the following questions (in addition to your own) to facilitate conversation after each video session.

Regular conversation breaks will encourage community, facilitate creativity, build excitement, and help your people stay engaged throughout the conference.

Choose the questions you think best follow each video and aim for 3-4 questions for every 15-minute block of discussion time.

Research suggests that conversation happens best in groups of 3-5 people.

Possible Questions:

- What most impacted you about that last session?
- Name a suggestion you just heard that you would like to implement in your children's ministry?
- What can you use from that last session to encourage a child or parent in your church?
- Tell us about an idea you heard in that video that you'd like to use in your children's ministry. Would you need to adapt it to fit your church? If so, how might you do that?
- What other ideas would you add to what the speaker said in that last presentation?
- Did that speaker motivate you in some way? If so, please share.
- How did that video session help you think more creatively about what you're doing in children's ministry?
- What new information or ideas did you receive from that session?
- What resonated with you from that last video?
- Was there anything you disagreed with from that last training? If so, what was it? Why do you disagree?
- What is one thing you'll do differently after watching that video?
- How did that video inspire you to be more intentional or strategic with the children in your care?
- What has been most helpful for you today as a children's ministry leader?
