



# BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

ELEMENTARY BIBLE STUDY GUIDE INTRO

## WELCOME

The second piece of the Armor of God that we will study is the Breastplate of Righteousness.

We need to remember that all these pieces of Armor are created and given to us by God himself. Because of this, we can trust that they will work. In battle, the breastplate protects the vital, life-giving organs like the heart and the lungs.

The Bible refers to the heart as the center of who we are as a person, our intellect, emotion and will. That is why we must guard it above all else. We must not allow anything in or out of our heart that is not pleasing to God – guard what you watch, listen to, read, think about and talk about. This is what the Bible calls “righteousness,” meaning to live right with God. We must have God’s help to do this.

<p><b>READ ROMANS 3:22</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> How can we know we are made right with God?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> We must have faith and believe in Jesus Christ.</p>	<p><b>READ PHILIPPIANS 3:9</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> What happens when we belong to Jesus Christ?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> We are made right with God because of our faith in Jesus Christ. When we belong to Him, we want to follow Him and do things His way.</p>	<p><b>READ PROVERBS 4:26</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> Why can't we just do anything we want to do?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> Because we belong to God, we must be careful and always do what is right.</p>	<p><b>READ PROVERBS 4:23 NIV</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> When the Bible talks about our heart, is it talking about our physical, beating heart or something else?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> The Bible talks about our heart as being who we are and what we think.</p>

<p><b>READ PROV 4:23 NIV</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> What does it mean to "guard your heart"?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> Don't allow anything in or out of your heart (mind) that is not pleasing to God.</p>	<p><b>READ PROV 4:23 ICB</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> What are some things you think about?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> What we watch and listen to determines what we think about. What we think about determines how we live.</p>	<p><b>READ PSALMS 106:3</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> What happens if we do what is fair and we live right with God?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> God says happy are the people who always do right.</p>	<p><b>READ ISAIAH 32:17</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> What else can we expect if we are fair and live right with God?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> God says that fairness, or living right, will bring peace, calm and safety.</p>

<p><b>READ GENESIS 15:6</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> How can we keep living right with God; or to live like He wants us to live?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> Believing God's promises are true, having faith in Him and obeying Him will keep us right with Him.</p>	<p><b>READ ISAIAH 59:17</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> Is the armor of God important for us?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> Isaiah tells us that God used this same armor before He gave it to us.</p>	<p><b>READ LAM 3:22-23</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> What do we know about God's love?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> God's love for us never ends. He will never stop protecting us - you can trust Him.</p>	<p><b>READ EPHESIANS 6:13</b></p> <p><b>Talk About:</b> Will God's armor help us?</p> <p><b>Think About:</b> God says His armor will help us stand strong. With God's armor on, we can fight and win.</p>
