### FOCUS VERSE

### PARENTS:

### AT-HOME ACTIVITIES:

- Take turns walking around the house blindfolded. Have 1 person in your family use only their voice to guide the blindfolded person around. Discuss what it must have been like for Saul to see Jesus, become blind, and then be able to see again.
