To be considered for the scholarship an applicant must:

1. Be a member in good standing of an International Pentecostal Holiness Church (IPHC).
2. Submit proof of acceptance in a graduate program in the field of ministry (includes Pastoral, Chaplaincy, Missions, Christian Education, Teaching, Music, etc) at an institution accredited by an organization or agency recognized by CHEA (Council for Higher Education Accreditation).
3. Be committed to do ministry under the umbrella of IPHC. (At least three years of ministry are required. There is a \$1,000.00 pay back per year, if less than three years.)
4. Submit a typed essay including:
 - A clearly defined plan for the future and how this award will help achieve that plan including personal goals and the ways which your educational pursuits relate to the broad ministry in the IPHC
 - Your financial situation and any other relevant information you would like for the scholarship committee to consider
 - Past and current involvement in ministry
5. Submit three (3) current letters of recommendation. These letters should reflect your academic qualities as well as personal reflections upon your life in the church.
 - Professor or advisor
 - Conference Superintendent
 - A person within the IPHC (pastor, etc.)
6. Submit a transcript of most recent educational degree.
7. Submit a video, one minute in length, stating why you should be considered for this scholarship award. This video does not need to be professionally produced and is an OPTIONAL inclusion, not a requirement.
8. Application must be received by **July 1st**.

By signing below, I am stating that I understand since the International Pentecostal Holiness Church is making an investment in my ministry, if I do not continue my ministry in the IPHC, I will repay this investment according to #3 above. I also understand that if the award is made payable to me instead of my institution, that I will be required to fill out a W-9 for those funds. The IPHC GMC will provide me with a 1099 at the end of the year. This award may be subject to income tax if I am unable to provide documentation that the entire amount was used for qualified educational expenses.
