Foreword by the WMM Executive Director

At the 28th General Conference in 2017, Presiding Bishop Dr. A.D. Beacham put forth the Arise 2033 vision to plant 5,000 new churches outside of the U.S. and establish an IPHC ministry presence in 50 new countries by 2033. In 2018, World Missions Ministries began training and resourcing missionaries, national leaders, church planters, pastors, and evangelists in six strategies. Those strategies are **(1) prayer, (2) evangelism or winning the lost, (3) discipling believers, (4) planting churches, (5) targeting the 8,000 unreached or unengaged ethnic groups in the world, and (6) changing a paradigm by challenging nations to become sending as opposed to receiving nations.**

As a result of the Lord at work in our midst, our 2022 World Missions Statistical Report shows that we now have a ministry presence in **107 countries**, not including the United States, Canada, and Brazil. **We also report having 13,559 churches and a membership of 1,564,493 members outside of the U.S.** We glorify the Lord of the harvest.

In 2022 we established a ministry presence in **five new countries: Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, and Equatorial Guinea.** We also planted **920 new churches.** Since implementing our six strategies globally through our twelve regional networks, by God's grace, we planted **439 churches in 2018, 960 churches in 2019, 691 churches in 2020, 709 churches in 2021, and 920 churches in 2022 for a total of 3,719 new church plants in the past five years.**

As a result of our structural re-alignment, there are now 104 nations within our regional boundaries with no established IPHC presence. At the end of 2017, we were in 93 countries. At the end of 2022, we were officially in 107 countries. We have 43

more countries to establish a ministry presence in to meet our Arise 2033 goal. The 104 countries with no IPHC ministry presence must become our focused priority.

Our Regional Directors have identified 15 countries (from our listing of 104 countries with no IPHC presence) with the goal of establishing a ministry presence in them by the end of this year, 2023. These countries are:

- **Maldives and Mongolia** [Continental Asia Region]
- **Georgia and Jordan** [Eurasia & Middle East Region]
- **Croatia, Morocco, and Tunisia** [Mediterranean Region]
- **Somalia and Sudan** [Eastern/Sub-Saharan Africa Region]
- **French Guiana, Grenada, Guadeloupe, and Suriname** [Caribbean & West Indies Region]
- **Guinea, and Guinea-Bissau** [Western Africa Region]

As a testament to God’s hand at work, here is a snapshot of what you will find in the Statistical Global Summary, as well as the Statistical Regional Summaries:

The IPHC has 2,260 churches in North India where Bishop Michael John, a former People to People sponsorship child, now leads its remarkable growth and commitment to planting churches. Extraordinarily, Bishop Reshetinsky continues to plant churches in Ukraine as well as in Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bulgaria, and Russia, even while battling a raging war. In Ethiopia, the IPHC has 560,000 members—the most members of any other country globally. Bishop Desalegn Kekebo Oda serves as their visionary leader. And, on the continent of Africa, the IPHC reports having 6,384 churches and a membership of 1,099,368 members, making it the continent with our largest ministry presence.

We stand on a precipice again. We have the next eleven years to change and shape our destiny.

Our global trajectory continues to rise in unprecedented ways. This is our Season! This is our Kairos moment! This is our time to Arise! “Let’s attempt Great Things for God and expect great things from God this year. Let’s fulfill the Great Commission.”

The prophet Isaiah tells us in Isaiah 54:2 (TPT), “Increase is coming, so enlarge your tent and add extensions to your dwelling. Hold nothing back! Make the tent ropes longer and the pegs stronger.”

Never underestimate the effect that your partnership has had, is having, and will continue to have in kingdom expansion. The gospel of Jesus Christ, wherever it is preached, still has the power to save and set people free!

As one of my heroes in the faith, Philip List, Sr., used to say, **“Forward with the gospel!”**
