

How to Produce Much Fruit for God's Glory (And Exceed Your 2033 Goals)

B. **Key Thought:** The Great Commission Equipping Training (GCET) offered by *IPHC World Missions Ministries* is a powerful _____ to help you reach and surpass your 2033 goals. Why not give serious thought to using it, if you are not already doing so?

II. The Goal of GCET Training: To see ordinary churches transformed into _____. We concentrate on training pastors, evangelists, church planters, and missionaries to *Unreached Peoples*, both men and women.

A. A story of two churches.

1. An ordinary church which is not growing and not training its people to be involved in *The Great Commission*.
2. An extraordinary, Great Commission Church which is winning many lost people, discipling the people they win, effectively training and sending people into ministry, planting new churches, and bringing the Gospel to people who have never heard.

B. **What if there was a way** to see the churches in your country _____ from ordinary to Great Commission churches? Would you be interested?

Testimony of an IPHC national leader: "The Great Commission Equipping Training (GCET) has transformed our entire work from an ordinary work with ordinary churches to a Great Commission work with Great Commission churches. Through this training we have seen more than 500 new churches/house churches planted."

- III. The WMM Great Commission Equipping Training (GCET) concentrates in four areas:
- A. How to see people come to Christ _____.
 - B. How to effectively _____ those who come to Christ.
 - C. How to see new churches _____ more quickly.
 - D. How to see the world's _____ People Groups (UPGs) penetrated with the Gospel and see churches planted among them.
- IV. The GCET Training is conducted in two phases (Phase One and Phase Two) held four to six months apart.
- A. In Phase Two training, we receive reports from workers who were trained in Phase One training concerning what happened during the four-to-six-month period between the two trainings.
 - B. Here are some testimonies of the results of this training:
 - 1. One worker trained by MCI personnel is serving among the Malto people group in India. He reported that within the last six months 12 house churches were established in 12 different villages of his district. He says signs and wonders are bringing people to the Lord.
 - 2. Report from 15 workers trained in Ghana/Togo: 364 new believers; 210 baptisms; 187 believers disciplined; 18 new house churches in six months.
 - 3. Report from 20 workers trained in India: 642 new believers, 182 baptisms, 228 believers disciplined, and 72 new house churches planted in one six-month period in the most unreached country in the entire world.
 - 4. Report from 15 workers trained in Pakistan: 470 new believers; 455 new members gained; 199 baptisms; 225 believers disciplined; 500 church members trained to disciple new believers; and 27 new churches/ house churches planted in six months.

5. Report from Ethiopia (total results): 5,563 new believers; 6,291 baptisms; 1,897 people disciplined; 1,156 new churches/house churches; 185 UPGs targeted for prayer and outreach; 85 new cross-cultural missionaries working among UPGs.
6. Report from India: one pastor who was trained in GCETs has raised up 70 powerful young church planters (both men and women). They have planted 220 house churches in the past two years.
7. Report for Uganda: one pastor who was trained has seen more than 1,000 new believers won to Christ and disciplined and has planted 27 new churches.

C. How are these results happening?

1. Workers are using the WMM Great Commission Equipping Training (GCET).
2. What about YOU? Can this training help you reach and exceed your 2033 goals? (Note: One powerful truth that is taught in the GCETs is: **“Everything that is living and healthy reproduces spontaneously.”**)

D. The Next Step (if you are interested)

1. Give your adjusted 2033 goals to your Regional Director.
2. If you are interested in using the GCET training to help transform your churches into Great Commission churches, here's what to do next:
 - a. Decide on a key person in your country to be trained as a GCET Master Trainer – either yourself or someone else.
 - b. Communicate this with your RD. He will help you get that person trained effectively.
3. Watch your churches come alive, grow rapidly, and surpass your 2033 goals – produce much fruit for God's glory (John 15:8).
