INTRODUCTION



The Link has served as a daily prayer guide highlighting the influence of IPHC's World Missions Ministries since its inception in the early 1980s and has helped launch a global movement that is a powerful intercessory prayer force today, which I believe has been foundational to our success as a Missions Ministry.

Thanks to the creativity and giftings of Mrs. Whitney Browning Nix, **The Link** has undergone a major transformation. I trust you will find this condensed format beneficial. The focus has been and always will be on our missionary families. We can never thank you enough for the prayer

covering that you provide for them.

In 2017, World Missions Ministries was challenged to establish a ministry presence in 150 nations and birth 5,000 new congregations outside of the United States as we Arise Together by the year 2033. Since implementing six strategies globally through our twelve regional networks beginning in 2018, by God's grace, we have planted **3,719 new churches in the past five years**. There are 104 nations within our 12 regional boundaries with no established IPHC presence. **At the end of 2017, we were in 93 countries. At the end of 2022, we were in 107 countries—that's an increase of 14 new countries.** We need to reach 43 more countries by 2033!

Join us in praying that Pentecostal Holiness Churches around the world will be awakened:

- by our vision and call to prayer
- to the urgency and need to reach the lost
- to their responsibility to disciple new believers
- and understand the importance and priority of planting new churches
- and understand that we have been commanded to go and make disciples of all ethnic groups and that as believers of Christ Jesus, we are obligated to reach the unreached and unengaged
- and understand that with immigration demographics being what they are today, that this is a "Kairos", or opportune moment, in time to position our existing 104 nations to become SENDING as opposed to RECEIVING nations

Our global trajectory continues to rise in unprecedented ways. This is our time to Arise Together.

Your intercessory investments are making a difference. Let's "Continue steadfastly in prayer" (Colossians 4:2) in 2024!

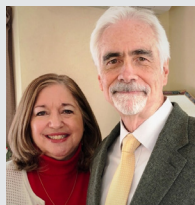

Banagas in your prayers as they serve as missionaries in the Philippines and work to see Kingdom expansion.

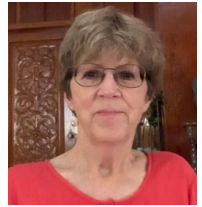
Douglas & Remy Barton

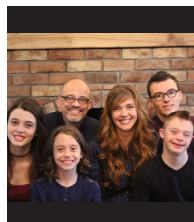
Larry & Deborah Mininger

Aaron & Esther Helland



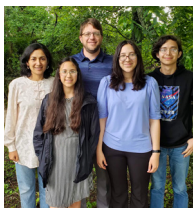
